Tamil Nadu	Dharmapuri Boys	41	\$18,450	Swamini Viswapriyananda Saraswati	The land was donated by Smt. Vimala Ram Mohan Pai from Banglore and the building by Smt. & Sri. Ram Kini, in memory of Sri.Ram Kini's mother Smt. Sumithra. Inaugurated in 2011. The children are from neighboring tribal villages and attend Government High school.		
Maharashtra	Ramtek Boys	34	\$15,300	Swami Vishwaswaroopananda Saraswati	Land with building leased by Shri Kavi Kalidas Shikshan Santha. Expecting 10 more students. Students attend school attached to the Kalidas Sansthan.		
Himachala Pradesh	Solan Boys	37	\$16,650	Acharya Navneethji	Building donated by Smt Chandrika Tandon. Inaugurated in 2002. The students come from nearby 19 villages and are mostly from an agricultural background.		
Karnataka	Dharwad I Boys	65	\$29,250	Swami Chitrupananda Saraswati	Land & Building leased by Akshaya Trust Home situated in heart of Dharwad city but students hail from remote villages.

New Free Student Home in state of Bihar, Sheikhura district

- The land in Sheikhura district, Bihar, was donated by Mr. S.K. Sharma, who has been coordinating the Ghazipur health care center Jawahar Dharmartha Chikitsalay. It is his personal land and he will take care of the student home. He is a civil engineer retired from government service.
- We have developed a standard plan for FSH. Constructing the FSH with all allied facilities including development of land, compound wall etc. would cost approximately Rs 64 lakhs at current prices. However we can make more detailed estimate based on actual site conditions and firmed up final plan in due course.
- Sri Satyendra Kumar Sharma is a devotee of Pujya Swamiji. He, along with his brother Sri Shailendra Kumar Sharma, donated 50% of the land at their native village "Maur", Barbhiga, Shiekhura District in Bihar for starting a new FSH.
 - This is a remote village and surrounded by other villages. The inhabitants of the village are labourers. There is a high school close to this village.
 - o There is a demand for an FSH and about 40-50 students can be accommodated here by constructing one of about 4000 sq ft.
 - The approximate cost for the building, compound wall and other infrastructure will be around Rs 60-70 Lakhs.
 - The land is fit for the construction process to be initiated immediately. This would be our first Free Student Home in Bihar.
