



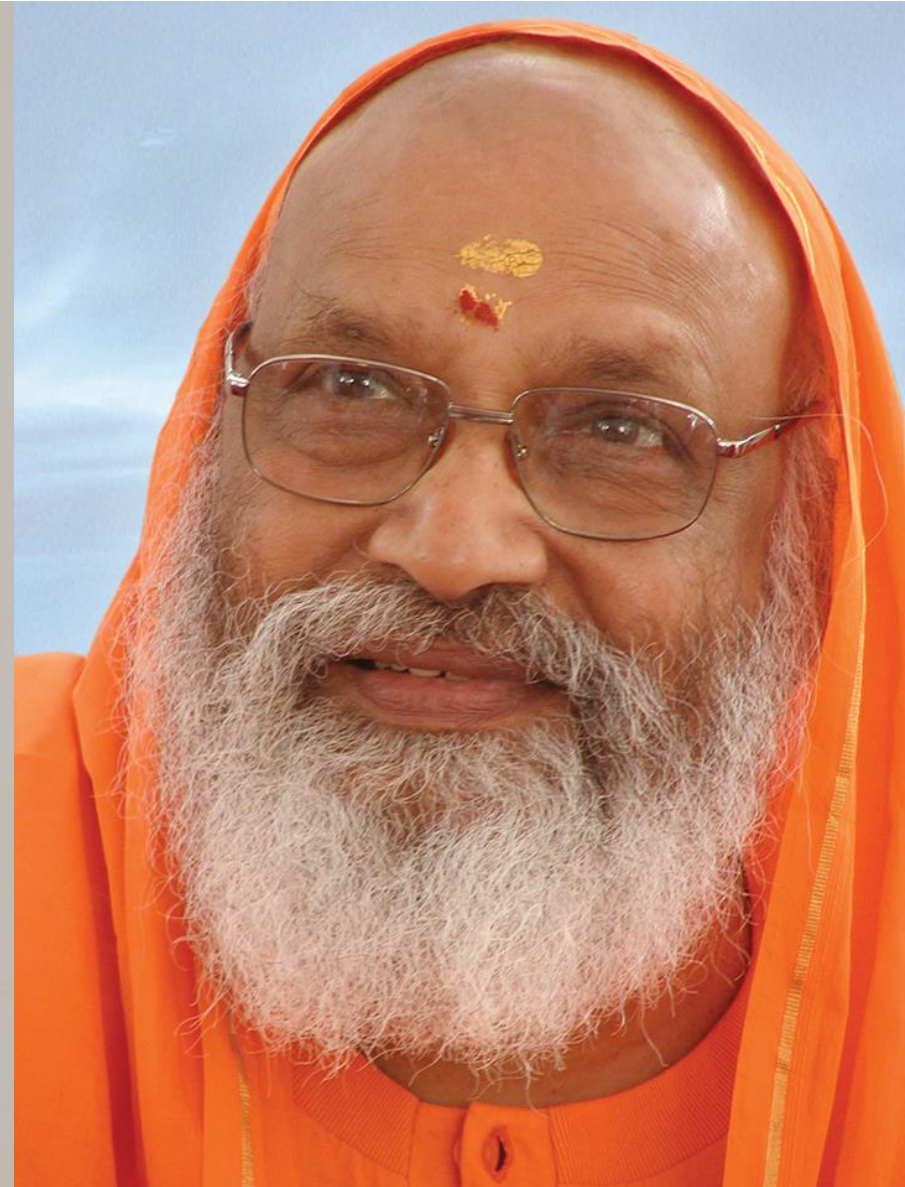

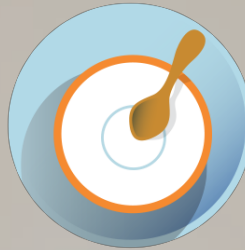

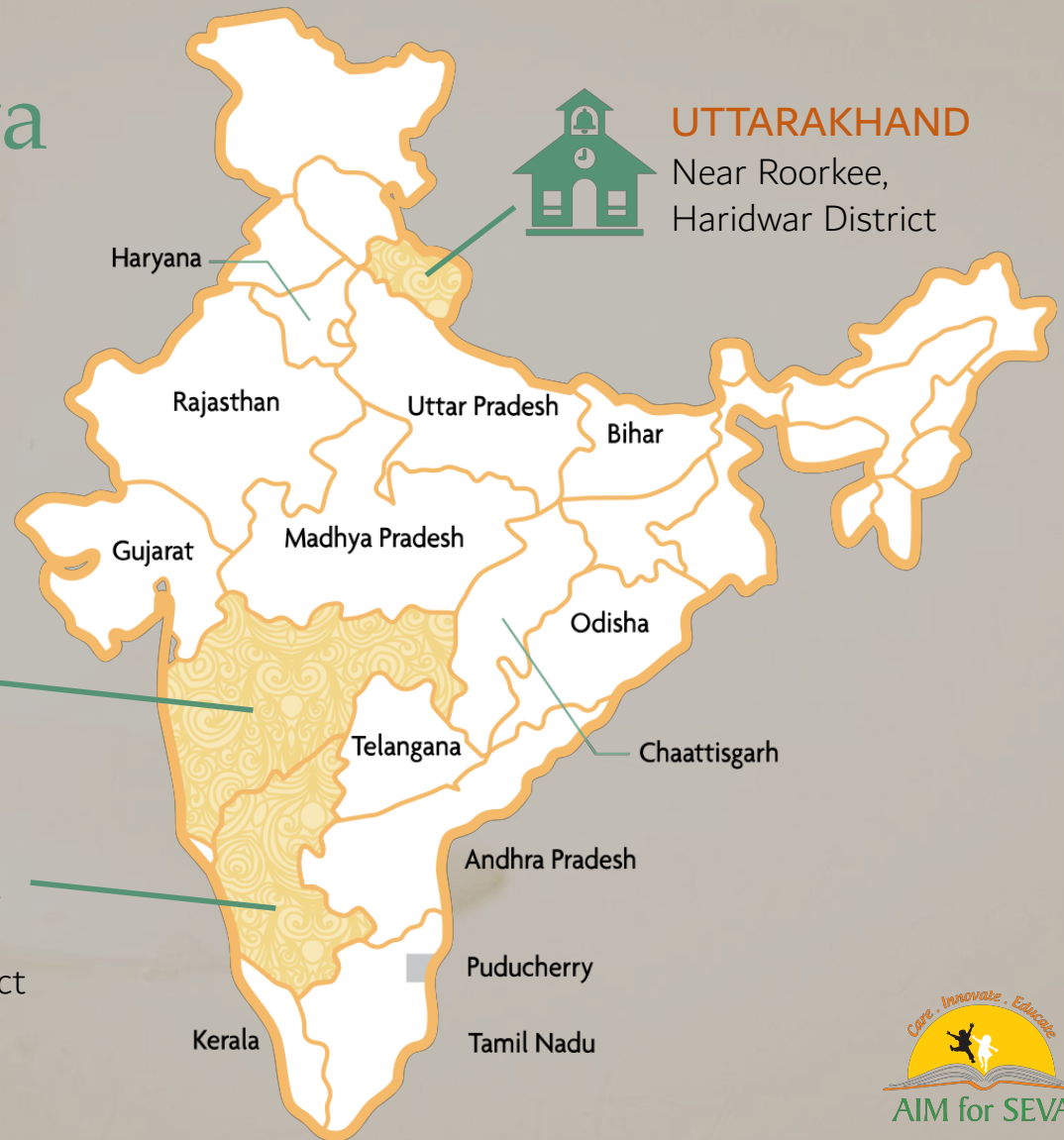

Residential School Campus Plan



Proposed Campus Timeline

PHASE 1

October 2020-March 2021

Identification, procurement and preparation of land for the campus

PHASE 3

June 2022

Construction of Kindergarten to Class 3 classrooms
Construction of ground floor for both hostels
Construction of first floor of school and additional washroom block

PHASE 5

June 2024

Completion of the entire campus consisting of:
School (ground + 2 floors)
Boys' and girls' hostels (ground + 1 floor)

PHASE 2

April 2021

Construction of school ground floor consisting of 15 classrooms and a washroom block (left wing – 5 classrooms, center wing – 5 classrooms, right wing – 5 classrooms)
Construction of compound walls and other facilities in and around the campus

PHASE 4

June 2023

Construction of first floor for both hostels
Construction of second floor of the school and additional washroom block

Note: Timeline is tentative and subject to modification as construction progresses.

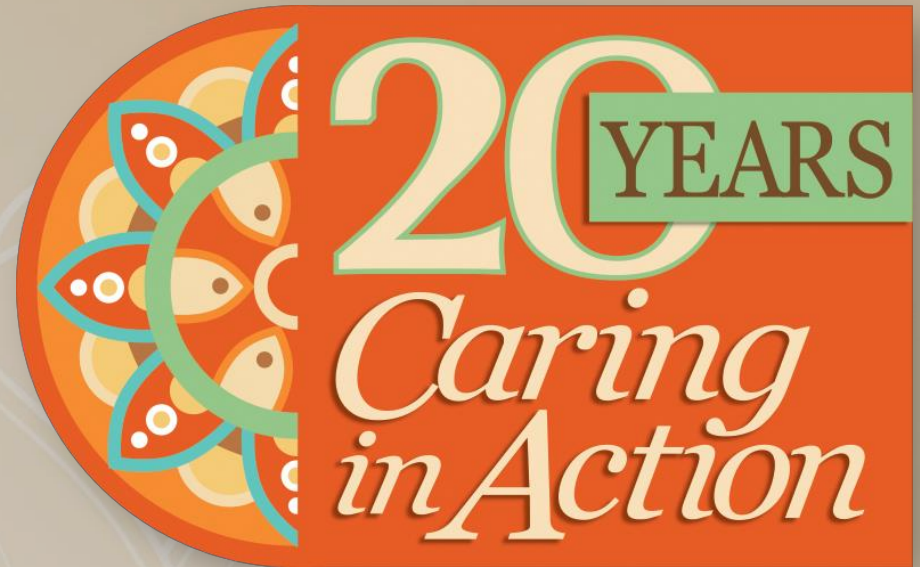
